



Fitting the mobile telephone bracket/ Inserting the mobile telephone



1. Press the cradle (1) into the catches of the bracket (2) and push it upwards until it audibly engages.



2. Insert the mobile phone (3) into the bracket (1) as illustrated.



The use of a Bluetooth® headset is not possible in hands-free mode.

The mobile telephone switches to handsfree mode when switched on and inserted.

In order to connect to the Mercedes-Benz hands-free feature in the vehicle, the following settings have to be made:

Transferring the telephone book to the operating system/on-board computer The telephone book cannot be transferred under the following conditions:

- Remaining in Start-up menu.
- Music only is selected.

The Start-up menu setting has to be deactivated, refer to mobile telephone ope-

Access to the telephone book in the SIM card via the Mercedes-Benz hands-free feature is not possible. Telephone book entries in the SIM card must be copied to the telephone book in the mobile telephone, refer to mobile telephone operator's manual.

Depending on the service provider, some of the functions of the Mercedes-Benz handsfree feature cannot be used if the mobile telephone is operating with a pre-paid SIM card.

It is only possible to activate the suppression of call numbers on the mobile telephone, see mobile telephone operator's manual.



A dialling shortcut function can be used on Mercedes-Benz audio systems with a number pad. With numbers 1 through 9, memory locations 1 through 9 in the telephone book can be accessed.

Memory locations 1 through 9 in the telephone book must be occupied, refer to mobile telephone operator's manual.

For example, if a telephone number is to be saved in location 1, it has to be selected on the number pad and then it can be renamed in the mobile telephone, refer to the mobile telephone operator's manual.

Removing the mobile phone/Detaching the mobile phone bracket



1. Slide the lock (4) upwards and remove the mobile telephone (3) from the holder (1).
